### **PLEASE NOTE:**

**\*\*\*EB and WB I-70, 110<sup>th</sup> St. to I-435, pavement improvement project is complete; no further lane or ramp closures are scheduled.**

**\*\*\*U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> St.)/I-70, bridge maintenance project is complete; WB I-70 to SB U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> St.) exit ramp has reopened and U.S. 169 and I-70 lanes are fully reopened to traffic.**

**\*\*\*K-32 and 222<sup>nd</sup> St., intersection improvement project is complete; pilot car operation has ended and no further lane closures are scheduled.**

**\*\*\*Jefferson Co.: U.S. 59 approximately 3 miles north of U.S. 24; Johnson Co.: I-435 at Johnson Dr.; Leavenworth Co.: K-32 at Hemphill Rd.; Wyandotte Co.; K-5 near 18<sup>th</sup> St., I-435 north of Woodend Rd., I-435 at Wolcott Dr., stormwater pipe repair work is complete; no further shoulder, lane or ramp closures are scheduled.**

## **JOHNSON COUNTY**

*KDOT short-term closures:*

**NB and SB U.S. 169 at 199<sup>th</sup> St., December 4-23, NEW.** No eastbound turns from U.S. 169 to 199<sup>th</sup> St. to expand eastbound turn lanes.

*KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:*

**NB U.S. 69/179<sup>th</sup> St. to 191<sup>st</sup> St., start date June 14, ONGOING.** Bridge maintenance project; NB U.S. 69 will be reduced to one lane for bridge maintenance (short-term intersections closures at 162<sup>nd</sup> St. and 175<sup>th</sup> St.). Work will occur 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, with work on Saturday as needed. Project completion expected by early December.

## WYANDOTTE COUNTY

*KDOT short-term closures:*

### **I-435/Missouri River:**

**December 7, NEW.** NB I-435 right lane closed for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**December 8, NEW.** NB I-435 right lane closed from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and SB I-435 right lane closed from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m. for bridge inspections.

**December 9, NEW.** SB I-435 right lane closed for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

### **I-70/Fairfax Tfwy.:**

**December 7, NEW. Ramp closed** (SB Fairfax Tfwy. to EB I-70 entrance ramp) for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**December 8, NEW.** WB I-70 right lane closed and **ramp closed** (WB I-70 to Washington Blvd. exit ramp) for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**December 9, NEW. EB I-70 roadway closed** (James St. exit to Missouri state line) for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. EB I-70 traffic will be diverted to James St. exit.

*KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:*

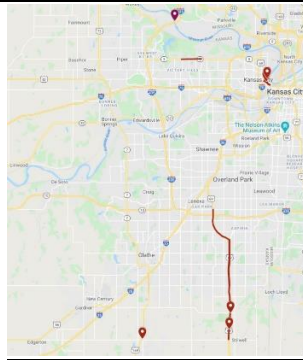
**Unified Government project. Leavenworth Rd./K-5 from 78<sup>th</sup> St. to 63<sup>rd</sup> St., start date February 15, ONGOING. Roadway improvement project;** roadway reduced to one 11 ft. wide lane of thru traffic using flagging operation. Improvements include grading, surfacing and storm sewer work. Work will occur during daylight hours; project completion expected by mid-December.
