Survey for proposed K-92 pavement replacement in Leavenworth County has begun

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) began a field survey, Tuesday, May 18, for a proposed pavement replacement in Leavenworth.


The stretch of K-92 roadway affected by the proposed replacement is approximately one-half mile east and one-half mile west of the K-92/20th Street intersection.

The survey is to gather information that is necessary for the detailed design of the proposed improvement and is estimated to be completed by May 28.

Kara LaRiviere, P.S., Survey Project Manager, is in charge of this survey for KDOT.

A member of the survey crew first will contact property owners and/or tenants for permission to enter private property. Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the survey corridor.
