

## An update on KC Metro highway projects

Week of Nov. 22, 2021

### **PLEASE NOTE:**

**\*\*\*SB I-635, Missouri River to 34<sup>th</sup> St. bridge, pavement widening work is complete. SB I-635 is fully reopened to traffic.**

**\*\*\*NB and SB I-635/K-5 interchange, bridge replacement project is shut down for winter and will resume on or before March 12, 2022, weather permitting; completion expected in December 2022. NB and SB I-635 and SB I-635 to SB K-5 exit ramp are fully reopened to traffic.**

## JOHNSON COUNTY

*KDOT short-term closures:*

**I-435/U.S. 69, November 1-30, NEW – UPDATED.** Intermittent lane closures on I-435 and **intermittent ramp closures** (I-435/U.S. 69 interchange and nearby ramps) for geologic exploratory work from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**SB I-435, Woodend Rd. to Holliday Dr., November 29, NEW.** Intermittent lane closures for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**NB I-435, 53<sup>rd</sup> St. to Woodend Rd., November 30, NEW.** Intermittent lane closures for bridge inspections from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

*KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:*

- 1. K-7 at Prairie Star Pkwy., start date September 20, NEW. Interchange improvement project;** includes widening exit ramps to accommodate dedicated right and left turn lanes, adding traffic signals at ramp terminals and resurfacing Prairie Star Pkwy. Work will occur 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, with work on Saturday as needed. Project completion expected by late March 2022.
- 2. SB I-35, 151<sup>st</sup> St. to 167<sup>th</sup> St., start date August 16, ONGOING. Pavement patching and asphalt overlay project;** lane closures in areas where work is taking place. **Please see “Short-Term Closures” for applicable nightly closure info.** Work will occur from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. In spring

2022, paving work will resume on NB I-35. Project completion on SB I-35 expected by late November.

3. **NB U.S. 69/179<sup>th</sup> St. to 191<sup>st</sup> St.**, start date **June 14, ONGOING**. **Bridge maintenance project**; NB U.S. 69 will be reduced to one lane for bridge maintenance (short-term intersections closures at 162<sup>nd</sup> St. and 175<sup>th</sup> St.). Work will occur 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, with work on Saturday as needed. Project completion expected by early December.

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## **WYANDOTTE COUNTY**

*KDOT short-term closures:*

**NB and SB K-5, I-435 to K-7, November 5 – 26, NEW**. Single lane closures for boom mower operations from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

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*KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:*

1. **EB and WB I-70, 110<sup>th</sup> St. to I-435**, start date **August 23, ONGOING**. **Pavement improvement project**; lanes will be reduced, and ramps will be closed in areas where work is taking place. Work will occur Monday to Friday, with Saturdays as needed, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Project completion expected by late November.
2. **U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> St.)/I-70**, start date **June 16, ONGOING – UPDATED**. **Bridge maintenance project**; WB I-70 to SB U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> St.) exit ramp has reopened and U.S. 169 (7<sup>th</sup> St.) lane closures have ended. Underneath bridge, work is still active from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, and Saturdays as needed. Project completion expected by late November.
3. **Unified Government project. Leavenworth Rd./K-5 from 78<sup>th</sup> St. to 63<sup>rd</sup> St.**, start date **February 15, ONGOING**. **Roadway improvement project**; roadway reduced to one 11 ft. wide lane of thru traffic using flagging operation. Improvements include grading, surfacing and storm sewer work. Work will occur during daylight hours; project completion expected by mid-December.

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## **LEAVENWORTH COUNTY**

*KDOT construction project affecting traffic:*

**K-32 and 222<sup>nd</sup> St., west of Linwood**, start date **April 5, ONGOING**. **Intersection improvement project**; work includes grading and asphalt surfacing for new lanes. **Traffic will be carried through existing lanes for duration of project, using flagging and pilot car operation**. Drivers should expect delays of up to 15 minutes and may want to find an alternative route. Work will occur 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday to Friday and Saturdays, as needed. Project completion expected by late November.

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## **MULTI-COUNTY**

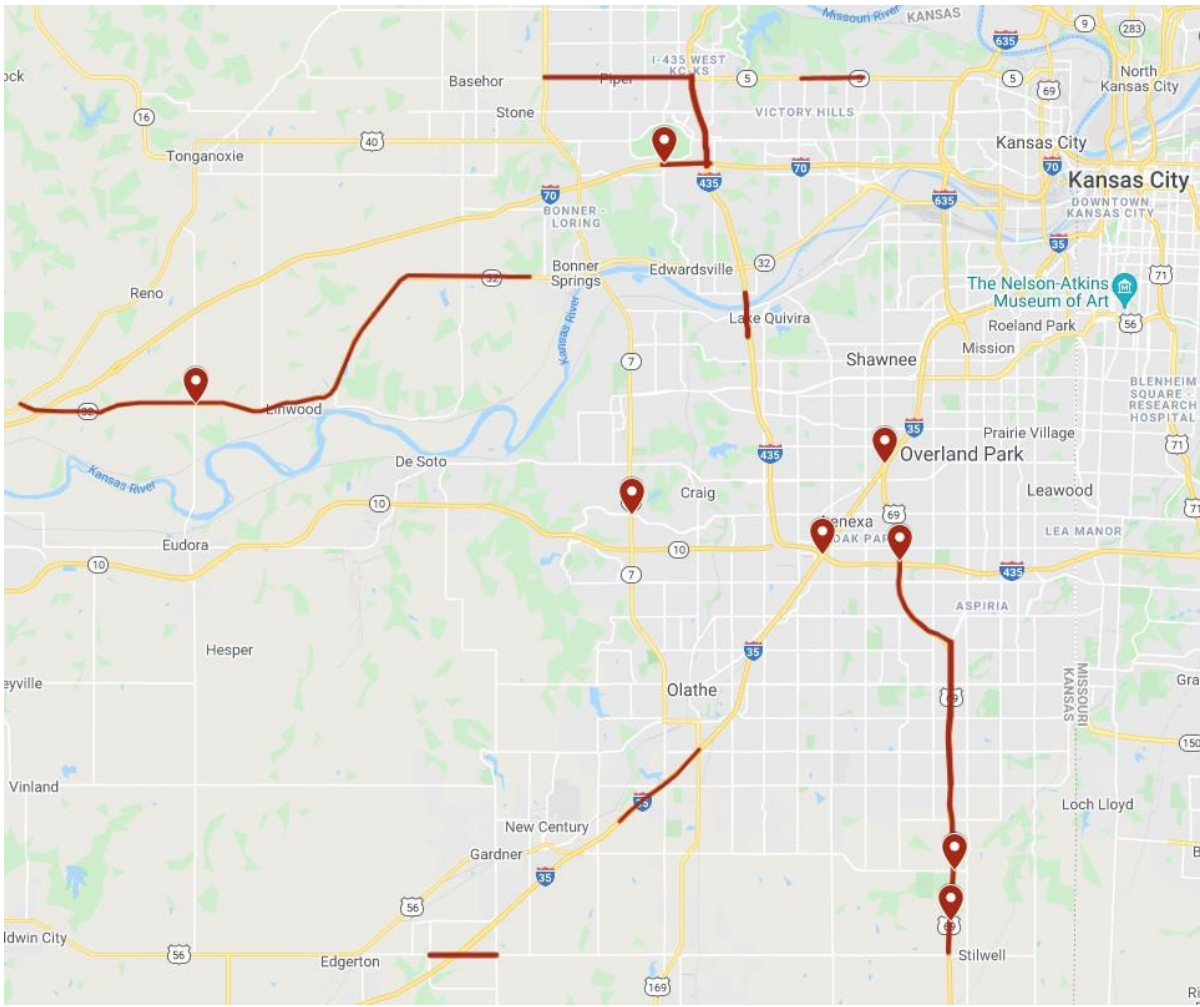
*KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:*

**Jefferson Co.: U.S. 59 approximately 3 miles north of U.S. 24; Johnson Co.: I-435 at Johnson Dr.; Leavenworth Co.: K-32 at Hemphill Rd.; Wyandotte Co.: K-5 near 18<sup>th</sup> St., I-435 north of Woodend Rd., I-435 at Wolcott Dr.**, start date **August 9, ONGOING**. **Stormwater pipe repair project**; lane and ramp closures as project progresses; work will take place during daylight hours. Work on I-435 in Wyandotte Co. and U.S. 59 in Jefferson Co. will be in the right-of-way and off the pavement; shoulder closures may be used in these locations. **Please see “Short-Term Closures” for applicable daily closure info**. Project completion expected by late November.
