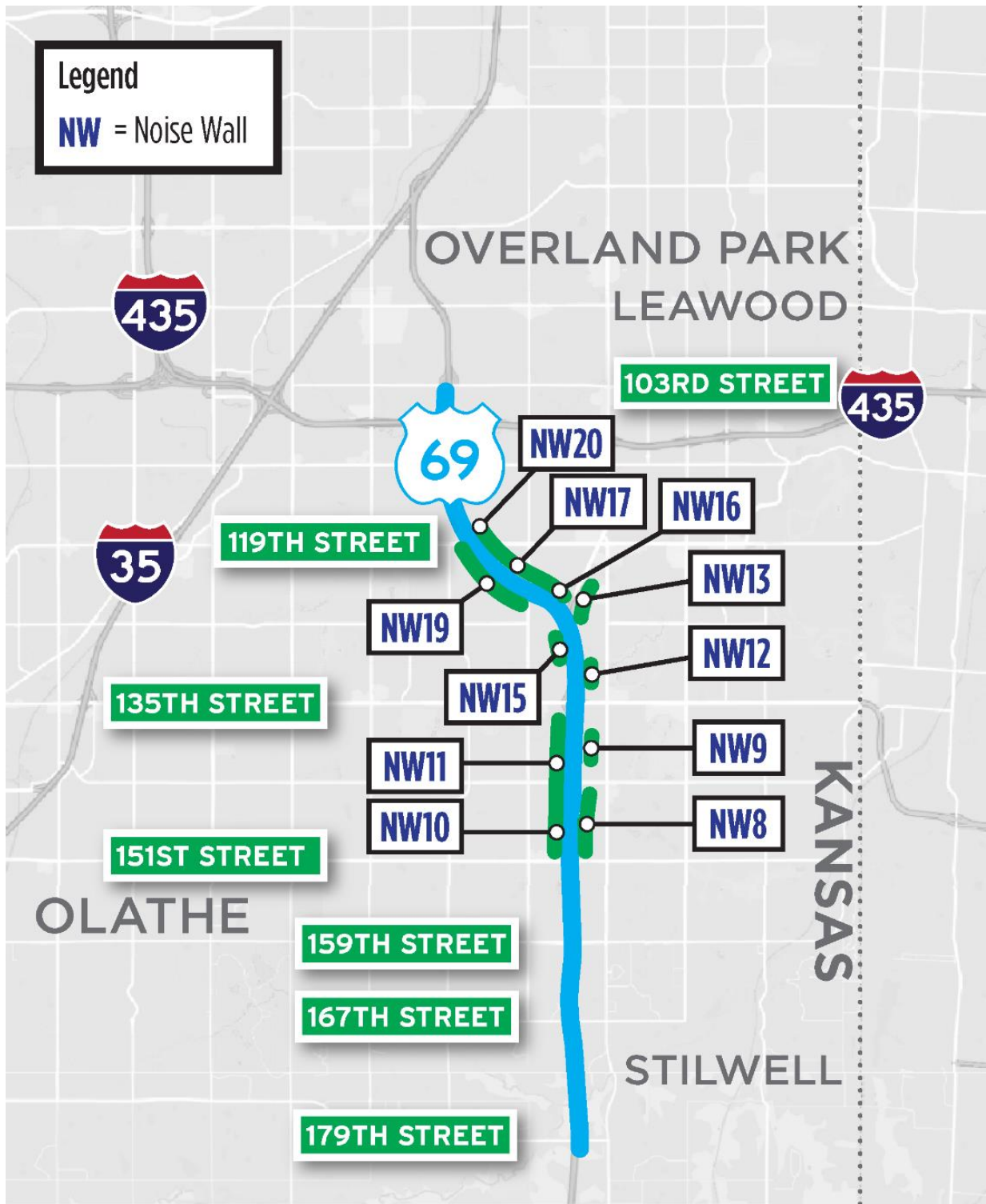

KDOT will build all proposed noise walls during 69Express construction

TOPEKA – The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will build all 11 noise walls proposed as part of the U.S. 69 Expansion Project, known as 69Express. Noise walls will be constructed in locations just north of 119th Street to 151st Street.

The proposed noise walls were identified through a Noise Study conducted in the fall of 2021. In early 2022, KDOT solicited input through a vote from residents and owners along the project corridor asking whether the walls are wanted. To proceed to construction, each proposed noise wall needed 70% or more of the votes received to be in favor of the wall. Final vote results exceeded that requirement for each of the 11 proposed walls.

The graphic below shows the 11 locations where noise walls will be built.
