Renner Road bridge project will begin March 18 in Johnson County

A bridge deck reconstruction project at Renner Road over I-435 will began Saturday, March 18 in Johnson County. The project will start with the demolition of the existing bridge, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT).

The demolition requires the full closure of two sections of I-435 from 10 p.m. March 18 to 5 a.m. March 21 – on southbound I-435 and associated ramps from Shawnee Mission Parkway to 87th Street, and on northbound I-435 and associated ramps from K-10 to Midland Drive. Renner Road at I-435 will close Thursday, March 17 at 8 p.m. and remain closed for the duration of the project.

After I-435 opens to traffic on Monday, March 21, reconstruction work will include bridge deck replacement, repainting bridge girders and enhancement of bridge lighting.

There also will be daily lane closures on I-435 in the project area. Traffic delays are possible, especially during the rush hours, and motorists are encouraged to use alternate routes. Work will occur Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., and Saturdays as necessary, with occasional overnight work from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Traffic will be controlled using portable message signs, arrow boards, signage, barricades and traffic cones. The project is anticipated to be completed in late August.

Clarkson Construction, of Kansas City, Mo., is the contractor for the \$3.4 million project.
