**20th St. at K-92 (Spruce St.) to be closed Oct. 19 and 20 in
Leavenworth County**

20th St. will be closed north and south of K-92 (Spruce St.) in Leavenworth County for pavement work on Wednesday, Oct. 19 and Thursday, Oct. 20, weather permitting.

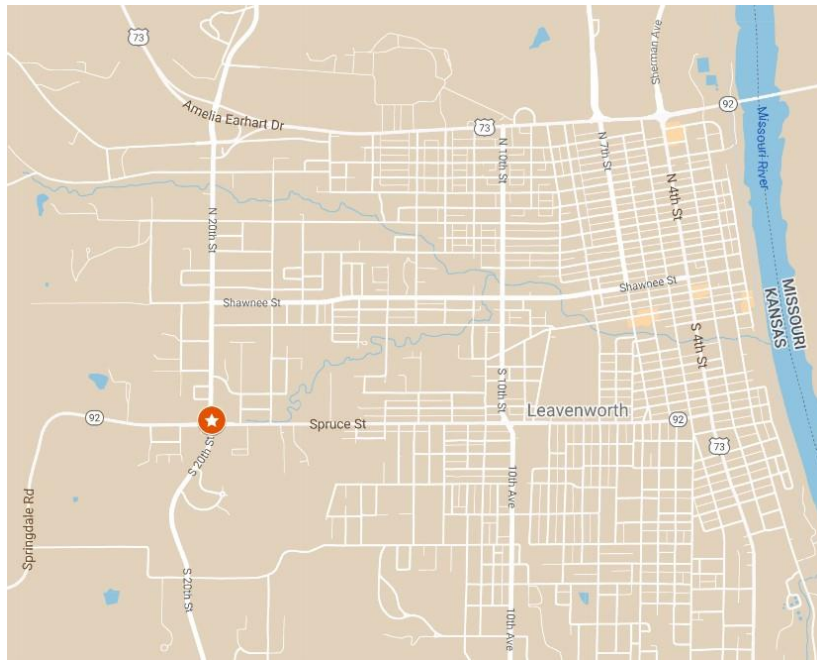
Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) maintenance crews will manage traffic with a flagging operation on 20th St. while work is taking place from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Minor traffic delays are expected in the area of the intersection.

Work will include overlaying the roadway with hot mix asphalt. Signs are posted to notify motorists of the upcoming closure and adjacent business have been notified.

Maintenance at this intersection will extend the life of the existing roadway until a KDOT pavement replacement project occurs. Bidding for the project opens in fall 2023 with construction planned for 2024.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.
