High mast tower lighting to be replaced in Wyandotte County

A Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) project is upgrading roadway lighting infrastructure in the Kansas City Central Industrial District. Work began Sept. 19 on multiple high mast light towers adjacent to I-70, I-670 and Central Avenue, between the Kansas-Missouri state line and the Kansas River in Wyandotte County.

Work will occur during daylight hours, Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m.

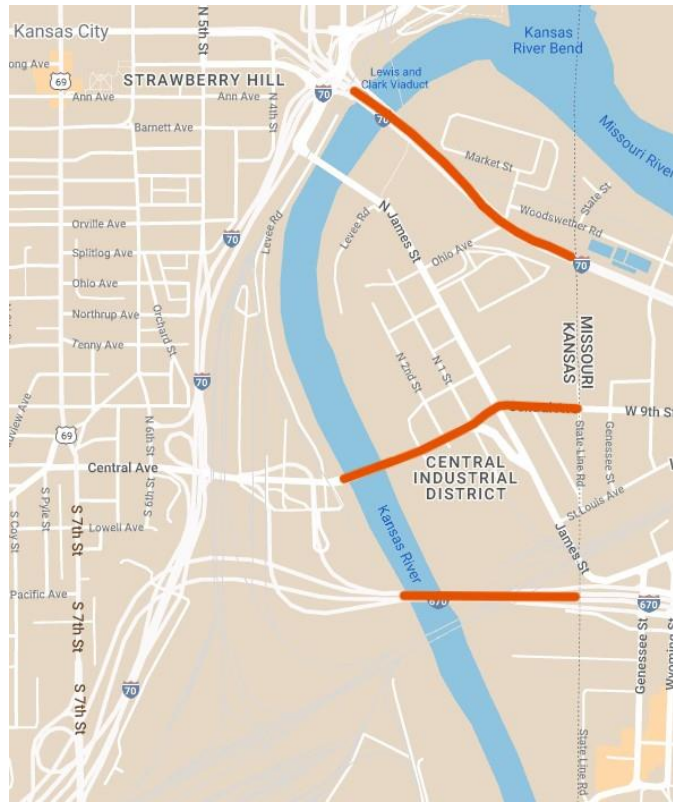
Impacts to traffic during the project will be minimal. Eastbound I-670 will have a single lane closure from Monday, Sept. 26 to Friday, Oct. 7 for project work on the Kansas River bridge.

Traffic will be controlled using portable digital message signs, arrow boards, signage and traffic cones.

Capital Electric, of Kansas City, is the contractor for the \$1.6 million project. The project will be shut down from December to January 2023 for material acquisition and is expected to be completed in February 2023.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1. Drive safely and always wear your seat belt.
