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I-435 pavement improvement project starts Monday in Wyandotte County

A Kansas Department of Transportation pavement improvement project on northbound and southbound I-435, from north of K-5 to the Missouri River, is scheduled to start Monday, April 1, in Wyandotte County, weather permitting.

The project includes milling and overlay and pavement marking of all I-435 lanes and adjacent ramps.

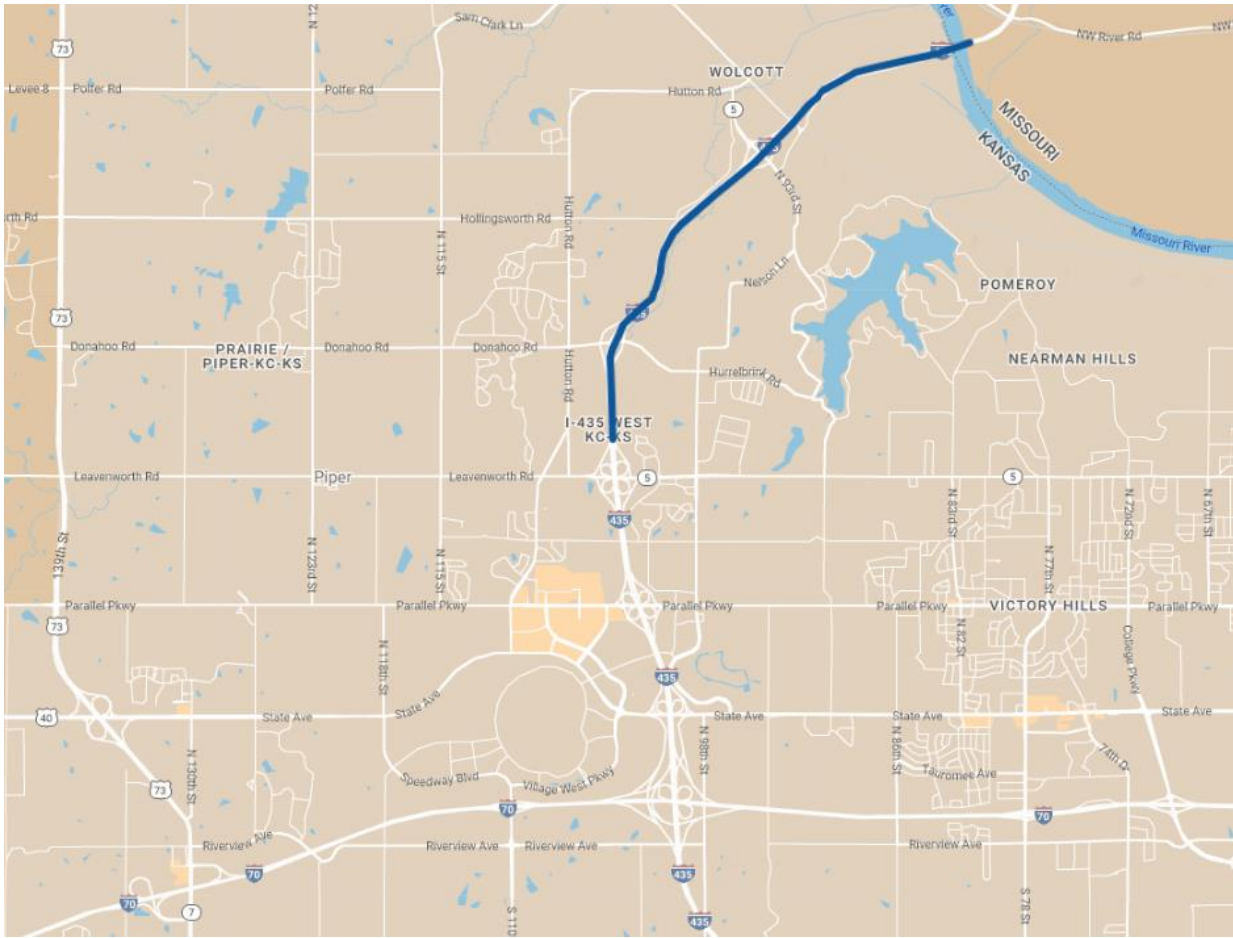
For the duration of the project, 24-hour work is permitted; daily and nightly lane and ramp closures will be scheduled. Message boards have been posted in the area to alert motorists of upcoming work.

Traffic will be controlled using lane and ramp closures, portable message boards, arrow boards, signage, barricades and traffic cones.

Ideker, Inc., of St. Joseph, Mo. is the contractor for the \$2.5 million project, which is expected to be completed in early May.
