## **JOHNSON COUNTY**

*KDOT short-term closures:*

**NB and SB U.S. 69, 103<sup>rd</sup> St. to 151<sup>st</sup> St., lane expansion & U.S. 69/167<sup>th</sup> St. interchange improvement project (69Express):**

**SB U.S. 69, 119<sup>th</sup> St. to Antioch Rd., February 26 – March 8, NEW.** Single left lane closed for project truck access nightly as follows:

Mon-Thurs: 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Fri: 8 p.m. to 10 a.m.

Sat: 6 p.m. to 10 a.m.

Sun: 5 p.m. to 6 a.m.

**EB 119<sup>th</sup> St. at U.S. 69, February 23 – March 1, ONGOING.** Outside right turn lane closed for utility work from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

**WB College Blvd., U.S. 69 to Switzer Rd., February 22 – March 22, ONGOING – UPDATED.** Single right lane closed for truck access from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (Mon-Fri).

**EB and WB I-435 at U.S. 69, February 21 – March 1, ONGOING - UPDATED**  
Alternating lane closures for bridge construction from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (Mon-Fri).

**EB and WB 139<sup>th</sup> St. at U.S. 69, February 12 – March 1, ONGOING – UPDATED.**  
Flagging operation for bridge construction from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (Mon-Fri).

**WB 135<sup>th</sup> St. at U.S. 69, January 31 – March 1, ONGOING – UPDATED.** Single right lane closed for project truck access from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**EB and WB 135<sup>th</sup> St. at U.S. 69, January 30 – March 2, ONGOING – UPDATED.**  
Double left lane closures for bridge work nightly as follows:

**EB 135<sup>th</sup> St. at U.S. 69, January 30 – March 1, ONGOING – UPDATED.** Single right lane closed for project truck access from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**119<sup>th</sup> St./NB U.S. 69, January 16 – March 1, ONGOING.** Outside right ramp lane closed (119<sup>th</sup> St. to NB U.S. 69 entrance ramp) for utility work from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (Mon-Fri).

**EB and WB 143<sup>rd</sup> St. at U.S. 69, January 2 – March 1, ONGOING.** Alternating lane closures for bridge work from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. (Mon-Fri).

**EB and WB 143<sup>rd</sup> St. at U.S. 69, January 2 – March 2, ONGOING – UPDATED.** EB and WB 143<sup>rd</sup> St. **fully closed** for bridge work from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. (Mon-Fri). *Detour will be marked.*

**NB U.S. 69 at 143<sup>rd</sup> St., January 2 – March 1, ONGOING – UPDATED.** Alternating lane closures for bridge work from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. (Mon-Fri).

**SB U.S. 69/135<sup>th</sup> St., January 2 – March 1, ONGOING – UPDATED.** Single right lane closed (SB U.S. 69 to 135<sup>th</sup> St. exit ramp) for project material delivery from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. (Mon-Fri).

**SB U.S. 69, 103<sup>rd</sup> St. to I-435, January 2 – March 1, ONGOING – UPDATED.** Single right lane closed for bridge construction from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

*KDOT closures:*

**NB and I-35/Lamar Ave. and 24<sup>th</sup> St., November 27 – April 2024, ONGOING.** Traffic control in place for traffic light installation on ramps from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., daily.

*KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:*

**NB and SB U.S. 69, 103<sup>rd</sup> St. to 151<sup>st</sup> St., and U.S. 69/167<sup>th</sup> St., start date February 16, ONGOING.** Lane expansion and interchange improvement project; work includes widening of NB and SB U.S. 69, from 103<sup>rd</sup> St. to 151<sup>st</sup> St., which will include a tolled express lane in each direction, and improvements to the U.S. 69/167<sup>th</sup> St. interchange. Area lane and ramp closures will be scheduled for the duration of the project, with traffic control changing as the project progresses. Work will take place daily and nightly. **Please see “Short-Term Closures” for applicable daily and nightly closure info.** Express lanes are scheduled to open in December 2025 with the project expected to be completed by the end of 2026.

## **WYANDOTTE COUNTY**

*KDOT short-term closures:*

**SB I-635 at Metropolitan Ave., February 27, NEW.** Single left lane closed for bridge project work from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

*KDOT closures:*

**EB and WB K-32/Turner Diagonal Fwy., 65<sup>th</sup> St. to 59<sup>th</sup> Ln., October 2023 – December 2024, ONGOING.** Roadway **fully closed** to traffic for bridge replacement project work.

**SB K-5, south of Sunshine Rd., March 2023 – December 2025, ONGOING – UPDATED.** SB K-5 bridge over Union Pacific Railroad tracks, south of Sunshine Rd., **closed to traffic** for maintenance work.

*KDOT construction projects affecting traffic:*

**Metropolitan Ave./I-635, start date February 23, NEW.** Bridge replacement project; work includes replacing the bridge, approach pavement, guardrails and traffic signals. Work will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Metropolitan Ave. at I-635 will be closed to traffic for the duration of the project, expected to be completed by December 2024.

**K-32/Turner Diagonal Fwy./Kaw Dr., start date October 2022, ONGOING.** Bridge replacement project; work includes replacement of the EB and WB K-32/Turner Diagonal Fwy. bridges over Kaw Dr. and the Union Pacific Railroad lines. Adjacent ramp closures and full K-32 closures are scheduled on EB and WB K-32/Turner Diagonal Fwy. from 65<sup>th</sup> St. to 59<sup>th</sup> Ln. Detours are marked. Work is scheduled in multiple phases with traffic control placed first to prepare for bridge replacements. Bridge work will begin in March 2023. Work will take place Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Project will shut down in November for the winter and resume in March 2023 and again from November 2023 to March 2024. Project completion is expected by December 2024.
