K-10 South Lawrence Trafficway Project-Related Roadway Closure

WEEKDAY LANE CLOSURES: Westbound K-10 left lane on either side of the Noria Road intersection in east Lawrence (Douglas County) will be CLOSED for the moving of rock material that will be used for bridge embankment construction work which began yesterday, Tuesday, July 15. Lane closures will take place daily, Monday-Saturday between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. We apologize for the late notice on this rescheduled lane closure start date.

Project work is scheduled to be completed on Saturday, July 26, weather permitting.

Traffic will be directed through the project work zone via signage and cones. There will be a 55 mph posted speed limit through the project work zone during working hours only throughout this project phase.


