KC Scout Services Update

On Friday, July 12, 2024, the KC Scout app, which includes live camera views, was restored for service on both Apple and Android formats. Users may need to update their apps for best results.

This is the latest public-facing restoration of KC Scout services. More restoration continues

with camera stream access for media partners and KanDrive.gov, KDOT's road condition website.

KC Scout, a bi-state initiative between the Missouri and Kansas DOTs to provide travel and traffic information for the Kansas City metro area, suffered a cyberattack on April 25. Since then, efforts to restore KC Scout services have been underway.

The DOTs and KC Scout thank everyone for their patience during the service outage and as efforts toward complete service restoration continues.
